Welcome to KID Museum Summer Camp 2016! We are so excited to have your child join us this summer. KID Museum's hands-on camps encourage kids to learn while doing and think creatively while having a great time.

Your child will be attending camp at KID Museum, located at 6400 Democracy Boulevard, Bethesda, MD 20817 (the lower level of the Davis Library with our own entrance, down and to the left of the main Davis Library entrance).

For morning camps, drop off is between 8:45 am and 9:00 am, with pick up at noon. For afternoon camps, drop off is between 12:45 pm and 1:00 pm, with pick up at 4:00 pm. For those staying for extended day, pick-up is at 5:00 pm.

On camp days, we ask that you provide your child with a labeled water bottle, nut-free snack, and bagged lunch if he/she are staying with us for the full day. Lunches will not be kept in coolers, so please include an ice-pack!

KID Museum Camp Policies

ATTENDANCE/MAKE-UPS

KID Museum does not guarantee that camps cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control (i.e. weather, power outage) will be made up; no refunds will be issued. We do not offer make-up camps due to a child's inability to attend.

CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to provide students with a safe and supportive environment, KID Museum does not tolerate any form of physical or verbal abuse, vandalism, or the use of any and all illegal substances. Any behaviors found in violation of this policy will be addressed and the student may be asked to leave camp, and no refunds will be issued. No weapons of any kind may be brought into the building. Furthermore, we do not make weapons or use objects as weapons at KID.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

We encourage campers to leave electronic devices at home, **including cell phones**. If a camp requires a laptop or tablet, KID Museum will provide it to all campers.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In cases of inclement weather, KID Museum may be closed if County or Federal Government offices are closed. On days in question, please call 301-897-5437 and/or check our web-site at www.kid-museum.org for up-to-date information on closings and delays.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Drop off for morning camps is between 8:45 am and 9:00 am, with pick up at 12:00 pm. For afternoon camps, drop off is between 12:45 pm and 1:00 pm, with pick up at 4:00 pm. For those staying for extended day, pick-up is at 5:00 pm. Please note that we cannot accommodate late pick-ups. If you are more than 15 minutes late, we will need to charge a \$10 fee and \$1/ minute thereafter to cover the cost of our staff overtime.

RELEASE AGREEMENT

By registering your student you agree to the following: Although every effort is made to provide a safe environment, I recognize there is always a risk of accident. By submitting a registration, I agree to be responsible for any medical bills incurred resulting from illness or injury during my student's participation at KID Museum. Students are expected to carry their own accident and medical insurance. I release KID Museum from any and all liability and/or claims or damages arising out of personal injury of any kind. If necessary, I authorize KID Museum to administer first aid and/or authorize medical treatment for my child.

SIBLINGS/GUESTS

In order to provide a safe environment for your child, we ask that siblings, parents and guests not accompany students to camp.
